## INTERN OF THE MONTH

Marta Celebic '23, Physics/Engineering 3+2 POE, received Super Internship funding to participate in an internship with Joksinženjering Engineering in Belgrade, Serbia. Marta attended a Career Chat in the Fall 2021 semester where she met Ethan Cree '15. As a result of advice she received from Ethan regarding the professional licensure requirements, she decided to pursue a "hands on" experience. During her internship, Marta worked to reconstruct the basement of NLB Commercial Bank. She learned how to use a concrete drill to take down the ceiling layers, as well as thermal insulation, and how to use a water jet, circular saw with a diamond blade to cut concrete. Her team created a concrete pillar with armature for steel poles, cut out large portions of the concrete flooring and weight bearing walls, and finally installed European steel I profile beams to provide a larger entrance for the bank's trucks.
