Biography: During Coach Curley's eight years as the Juniata head coach the Eagles have enjoyed the most successful era in program history. He currently ranks second in career wins and career winning percentage, and his teams have twice tied the school record for victories in a season. Named the 2006-2007 Commonwealth Coach of the Year, Curley's teams reached consecutive conference championship games and earned successive ECAC tournament bids in the 06-07 and 07-08 campaigns. Under his direction Juniata has adopted the philosophy of being the "hardest working team in basketball."

Facilities: Few colleges have a more attractive campus than Juniata. The 100 acres on College Hill provide a magnificent atmosphere and safe environment. Campers are housed in one of the residence halls on campus and have access to all the amenities in the residence hall.

The camp will utilize one of the many playing fields on campus. The intramural gym and mezzanine areas as well as the mat room will be available in case of inclement weather.

Additional facilities available include an indoor swimming pool, a fitness center and game room.



Program: The weekend team camp for high school varsity and junior varsity teams is limited to the first 25 teams registered. The camp emphasizes game experience. While teams have practice time, the goal is to have teams play as many games as possible over the three days. Teams will play up to three games the first day, four on the second day, and two on the final day. Each game will have four, eight-minute quarters, with official time kept. PIAA officials call many of the games, along with scorers and time keepers, thereby allowing coaches to work with their teams.
