REMOTE ACCESS (DIAL-IN) TIME LIMIT

To all RAS (Network Dial-In Users):

Starting in the Spring 2003 Semester all RAS Dial-In Users will be given a 6 hour per day limit. This limit is being imposed in order to give users who need this resource the opportunity to use it. We currently have 23 dial-in lines, which were heavily used during the Fall 2002 Semester. We hope this limit will provide better overall service to dial-in users. This limit may fluctuate up or down depending on the use of the lines. If you use VPN to connect to the network, this limit will not affect you.

Please note that RAS (Remote Access Service) is not provided as a full-time network link for off-campus housing. Its main purpose is to provide network connectivity for academic and work-related purposes when students, faculty, and administrators cannot be on campus to do their work.
