Checklist

- ☐ **Learn More about Juniata**
We are pleased you are considering becoming a member of the Juniata community! We hope that you will do all you can to prepare yourself for your Juniata experience. Carefully review all the information in your acceptance packet and our website (www.juniata.edu). If you still have questions, let us know. We'll be happy to put you in touch with a Juniata student, staff, or faculty member to provide you with the information you need.
- ☐ **Virtual Connection**
Connect with us virtually at www.juniata.edu/visit.
- ☐ **Notify Juniata of Your College Selection**
Once you have made your final decision, contact all the colleges to which you were admitted and let them know your choice. If Juniata is your choice, please include your \$200 deposit (matriculation fee) to reserve your space. Deposits should be made payable to Juniata College in U.S. dollars, and can be paid by check (bank draft), money order, electronic transfer, traveler's checks, or credit card. For your convenience, you may pay your deposit securely online at apply.juniata.edu/status. You will need your Juniata ID number to complete the transaction.
- ☐ **Receive Your I-20**
Juniata will issue I-20 forms in late May/early June. Do not schedule your visa appointment before then, as we cannot guarantee that your I-20 will arrive in time.

- ☐ **Submit All Final Academic Documents** *(if you have not already)*
Juniata must receive an official, final secondary school transcript with graduation date from all students. Make arrangements to send all final secondary school transcripts, certificates, diplomas, graduation certificates, SAT, ACT, TOEFL, IELTS, AP, IB and/or external examination results to Juniata when they become available. Graduate students must also submit official college/university transcripts and course descriptions, and a professional course-by-course credential evaluation report if enrolling from a non-U.S. university. **These items must be received before August 1.** Only original documents or certified copies will be accepted.
- ☐ **Plan for Your Arrival**
Pay attention to e-mails from the Center for International Education (CIE) and other offices at Juniata that will provide you with important details regarding your arrival and transition to Juniata. Finally, don't forget to provide your arrival information to the CIE if you need transportation to Juniata. For more information, visit www.juniata.edu/prearrival.
