Germany - Westphalian University of Applied Sci-

ences

City: Gelsenkirchen

Language: German

The university focuses on practical skills, much like a trade school. There are around 8,000 students and a strong emphasis on research and sharing that research to improve the local economy. Gelsenkirchen, a former coal mining town, has switched to a more modern outlook, focusing on solar power and parks. The town also offers a zoo with a boat ride around the park.

Faculty-Led Short-Term Programs Abroad

Business in China Cultural Analysis 4 cr.

Locations: Beijing, Chengdu, Shanghai

This course examines recent economic growth in China from a rigorous academic perspective, while exposing students to the business world through visits to various multinational enterprises. Students will also visit cultural and historic sites such as the Great Wall and the Jinsha Ruins. Includes: 1 credit course in the spring and a two-week, three-credit trip to China.

Business in Germany

Locations: Germany

This course examines how business is conducted in Germany and the European Union by exploring aspects of international business, economics, politics, and culture. This exploration will include an immersive two-week trip to Germany involving visits to several German businesses such as Volkswagen headquarters and Grolsch Brewery paired with culturally engaging trips to Bad Bentheim, Cologne, and Amsterdam.
