- Creative Game Design

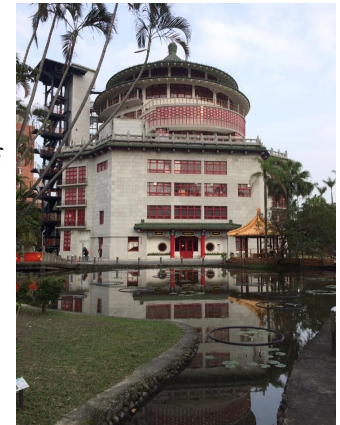
