**Hungry** - Budapest Semesters in Mathematics City: Budapest *Language: English* 

Through this program, mathematics POEs in their junior/senior years may spend fall, spring or summer semester in Budapest and study under the tutelage of eminent Hungarian scholar-teachers. The instructors of BSM are members of Eötvös University, the Mathematical Institute of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences, and Budapest University of Technology and Economics, the three institutions known for having educated more than half of Hungary's highly acclaimed mathematicians.

### **Taiwan** - National Chiao Tung University City: Hsinchu Language: English and Chinese

NCTU has an increasingly internationalized campus and has attracted students from more than 40 countries. To date NCTU has entered into nearly 300 international collaboration agreements, including dual degree programs, sister universities, and joint research projects. English-taught courses are offered in all nine colleges, while Chinese language courses are available for international students free of charge.
