See something? Say something. Do something!

EMERGENCY SUPPORT is required **immediately** when you encounter the following signs of distress:

- Expressions of suicidal ideation:
 - Threatening to kill or hurt oneself
 - Indications that one has a plan and/or the means to kill oneself
 - Seeking access to the means to harm oneself
 - Threatening suicide on social media or posts that focus on death, dying and suicide
- Threats of harm to others

NOTICE OF CONCERN should be submitted if you encounter the following signs of distress:

- Expressing serious personal concerns
- Poor personal hygiene
- Dependency: students want to be around you all the time or make excessive appointments
- Loss of interest in normal activities, withdrawal from social interactions, or seclusion
- Suspiciousness or feelings of being persecuted that seem unwarranted
- Decline in work/academic performance
- Missing class or work regularly
- Use of alcohol/drugs begins to escalate/interfere with normal activities
- Unusual irritability, outbursts of anger, unexplained crying, aggressiveness, excessive anxiety
