Intern Of the Month

Over the summer, student Kate Bock had a marine internship with Oceans Campus. The internship was an opportunity to learn about marine research and get hands on experience with marine research techniques. Kate got to perform tasks that helped ongoing research projects including chumming trips for identifying the white shark population in Mossel Bay, marine husbandry, maintenance for a small aquarium, fishing for and tagging smaller sharks, counting seals coming to and leaving seal island, towing decoy seals to assess white shark predation strategies, placing small sharks into tonic immobility, inputting data from chum trips, and more. She feels that, "I learned a lot of useful and marketable skills that are definitely going to help in my field of work. I also got to see firsthand what field research truly looks like and what it entails."

Kate will graduate in 2017, and plans to go to graduate school to earn her masters. Her internship made her consider a foreign graduate school rather than one in the US, as well as gave her a place of interest for future employment.
