Juniata student Drew Eline was a summer intern at Research Experience for Undergraduates, at the University of Colorado Boulder's Mountain Research Station. She heard of the opportunity through the director of Juniata's field station, Dr. Chuck Yohn. Working under Dr. Brett Woods, Drew researched yellow-bellied marmots at high elevations. She was able to design her own research project that studied the scent marking in yellow bellied marmots. She learned about experimental design and how to formulate hypotheses, as well as really looking at the surroundings and coming up with testable questions.

Drew felt that the program helped her go further in her field, and confirming what she wants to do in the future. She is currently a senior graduating in spring of 2016, and hopes to either do a Fulbright or go to graduate school.
