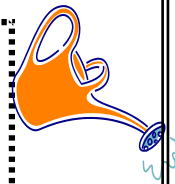

Non-Credit Transcript Notation

Did you know that your summer job could also double as an internship? *Qualifications for a summer internship:* A minimum of 240 hours, consist of pre-professional and academically-valid responsibilities related to your POE, and be performed in accordance with guidelines—The job can be a paid OR volunteer position.

If approved, a summer internship will appear on your official transcript (without grade or credit). Having a summer job qualifies as an internship, which requires satisfactory completion of various criteria.
