Summer Job Internship?
Do you know that your summer job could also double as an internship? Even if you find the position on your own without assistance from the Career Services Office, it could qualify as a non-credit, transcript-notation internship. *Essentially*, in order to qualify as an internship, a summer job must: Last a minimum of 240 hours, consist of pre-professional and academically-valid responsibilities related to your POE, and be performed in accordance with guidelines—The job can be a paid OR volunteer position.
If approved, a summer internship will appear on your official transcript (without grade or credit), and can be advantageous in the future as prospective employers, graduate schools, and similar persons review your transcript. Having a summer job qualify as an internship requires the satisfactory completion of various criteria.
If you are interested in pursuing internship qualification, please fill out the Internship Registration Form and appropriate Internship Learning Agreement Plan and return them to the Career Services office. Both forms can be found at <http://www.juniata.edu/services/career/students/internships/>

In the summer of 2013, Adam Caraballo was a student intern at Prime Research Clinic of the Yale University School of Medicine in New Haven, CT. As an intern he input research data, observed patient interviews, and scored neuropsychological assessments. He learned how to address patients properly and better understand the patients situations.
