

2016-2017 Private Alternative Educational Loan Guide

Before applying for a private alternative loan, you should complete the FAFSA to apply for other forms of financial aid that may be available to you. These sources may be the federal grant & loan programs and your eligibility for these programs would have been indicated on your financial aid award letter. If you did not receive an award letter from Juniata, please contact the Office of Student Financial Planning as soon as possible (and **before** applying for loans) to determine the status of your award.

If you are certain that you need to borrow a private education loan, Juniata College provides the following information to assist you with the process. The following lenders made loans to our students in the last 3 years and are willing to continue to lend to our students for 2016-17. You are not required to select a lender from this list. You may select any lender of private education loans. **If you decide to select a lender not on this list, please contact the Office of Student Financial Planning for further assistance.** Your choice of a private loan lender is never denied nor is the processing of a loan ever delayed if you choose a lender that may be new to Juniata College.
