Art Scholarship Portfolio Instructions

Welcome to this process. We are excited to meet you and look forward to reviewing your portfolio. Submission of your essay and portfolio will be **via Dropbox**; instructions will be sent via email upon registration.

- 1. Students will be required to present a digital portfolio of 10 artworks.
 - a. All artworks must be uploaded as individual files; links to websites will not be accepted.
 - b. If the artwork is a website you have designed, please submit screen shots and/or short (5 30 second) recordings that highlight specific features of the site
 - c. If submitting film and/or animation files, please limit them to 2-5 minutes per file.
 - d. Please refer to the photography guidelines below for tips on how to get the best results when photographing your artwork for your digital portfolio.
 - e. Please be on the lookout for a second email from Professor Benson outlining specific details for submission.
- 2. Students must also complete a 500-word narrative explaining, "Why you want to study Art at Juniata College?"
 - a. Essays are due upon portfolio review and should be included with the online portfolio submission.
