Juniata received funding from first CARES act; hoping to receive additional funds from CARES Act 2 passed in December and future Covid packages.</li> <li>Athletics are back at Juniata (Landmark ConfMoravian, Catholic, Drew &amp; Scranton)</li> <li>BELIEVE Campaign update – It began in 2014 and ends May 31, 2021.
