The Super Internship fund was established by a generous gift from Scott O'Neill '80, and has grown each year through donations from many Juniata alumni. The Endowment was created to support students taking advantage of internships that would otherwise prove cost-prohibitive.

Students can apply for up to \$5,000, which can be used to defray costs associated with housing, transportation, and other living expenses.

To apply, submit by March 15, 2023:

- Résumé
- Faculty Recommendation
- Unofficial Transcript
- Job Description
- Estimate of Living Expenses
- 1-2 Page essay on the topic of "How will this experience advance my future career plans?"

*Note: this is a rolling deadline. We will consider additional candidates after this date pending availability of funding.

- Able to dedicate 12 months to a full-time national service year

Intern Of the Month

Brian Standfest '23
Museum Studies and History

Brian interned with the East Broad Top Railroad in Orbisonia, PA, with the Archives and Special Collections. Brian first learned of the opportunity after participating in a class field trip and hearing about the internship that Juniata alumnus Sammy Bellin '21 participated in the previous summer. The internship enabled him to work on the National Railways Historical Society (NRHS) Heritage Grant, awarded to the EBTF for the East Broad Top Railroad Preservation of Architectural and Engineering Maps and Drawings Project. During his eight week experience, Brian worked with an archivist at EBT to develop a formal archive. While working on the Maps and Drawings Project, he created general inventory spreadsheets and a Data Dictionary using Google Sheets. Brian cataloged detailed parts drawings from various railcars, passenger cars, locomotives, and other machinery and buildings. This inventory included other objects like sketches of parts used in the EBT shops and architectural and engineering blueprint reproductions, linen maps, vellum maps, tracings, and sketches. Eventually, formal cataloging of these maps and drawings will occur in the collections management system and become available for public access as a digital collection catalog. Brian shared that he was able to witness Engine No. 6 steam for the first time during its restoration and added, "This archives internship has been invaluable and has opened my eyes to potential career paths after college."

Brian submitted an application to be considered for the PennACE Joanne Day Student of Year award in the Liberal Arts Category and was selected as this year's winner. Congratulations, Brian!
