

In the summer of 2013, Aaron Womer did an internship with Dr. Peter Dedon's lab at MIT in Cambridge, Massachusetts. The bio engineering summer research program, also called **BE-REU**, was suggested to Aaron by one of his Juniata peers.

During his internship, Aaron used **technical work** involving human tissue culture and sterile technique. He also became certified to work with research mice and was able to do procedures on them. Aaron learned skills such as **research collaboration, proper experimental design, and presentation skills.**

Without the help of the Career Services Office, Aaron would not have been able to participate in this internship. Aaron was chosen as one of Juniata's **Super Interns** in the spring so that he could afford his cost of living after the MIT's funding fell through.

Aaron plans on attending medical school, and intends on pursuing a career in **oncology**. He hopes to become a part of a private practice and conduct clinical research.
