- Cumulative GPA of 2.3 or higher

- RA Information Sessions: Quick session in which potential candidates hear from the Office of Campus Life on what they're looking for in RA candidates, what the job entails, and to determine if the RA position matches their personal ethos and skill sets.
- RA Application: Opens December 8, 2022-January 31, 2022. Applicants must submit the online application in order to be invited to join in the RA Mock Scenario and Carousel Group Interview Process. Additionally, applicants must have a GPA of at least a 2.3 in order to move forward in this process.
- RA Mock Scenario: all applicants will be paired with a current RA on staff and will go through a mock scenario provided by the Office of Campus Life.
- Carousel: Otherwise known as our group interview process, all RA candidates MUST participate in Carousel in order to be considered for an individual interview. Carousel will also have other applicants for other positions on campus present such as FYF Facilitator, JAB Board Member, and Inbound Leader.
- Individual Interviews: will be conducted by professional staff members of the Office of Campus Life. Not all individuals who participate in Carousel will be invited to an individual interview.
- Staff Notification: all candidates who participate in the Individual Interview will receive a notification of whether they've been hired and assigned to be an RA in a specific building/area for the upcoming year or if they've been assigned to our alternate list for the upcoming year.
