

#### **Executive Summary**

The Research Center of the Association of Independent Colleges and Universities of Pennsylvania (AICUP) conducts an annual tuition and fees survey. The study provides comparative information on undergraduate and graduate tuition for full-time and part-time students, as well as information on required student fees and room and board charges.

Some of the highlights of this report are shown here.

- Across all institutions participating in this survey, the median tuition for a full-time undergraduate student in the 2013-2014 academic year is \$30,000, an increase of \$1,000 from the 2012-2013 median of \$29,000. Across all institutions, tuition for full-time undergraduates rose by a median of 3.8 percent between the 2012-2013 and the 2013-2014 academic years. The smallest median percentage increase in tuition for full-time undergraduate students between the 2012-2013 and the 2013-2014 academic years was found in the Associate's Colleges category, which showed a median tuition increase of 3 percent.
- The median room and board charge for 2013-2014 is \$10,540, an increase of \$392 from the 2012-2013 median of \$10,148. Across all institutions, room and board charges rose by a median of 3.7 percent between the 2012-2013 and the 2013-2014 academic years.
- The median total cost (tuition, fees, and room and board) for a full-time undergraduate residential student in the 2013-2014 period is \$42,349. This is a median increase of 3.6 percent from the 2012-2013 academic year. Institutions in the Research and Doctoral Universities category had the largest median increase in total costs at 3.9 percent.
- The median increase in tuition for full-time graduate students from the 2012-2013 academic year to the 2013-2014 academic year was 3.5 percent.

#### Introduction

The Research Center of the Association of Independent Colleges and Universities of Pennsylvania (AICUP), under the direction of the AICUP Board of Directors and its standing Research, Assessment, and Accountability Committee, conducts an annual Tuition and Fees Survey. This survey is intended to provide comparative information on undergraduate and graduate tuition for full-time and part-time students, as well as information on required student fees and room and board charges.

The 2013-2014 Tuition and Fees report includes data from 86 of the 88 member institutions of AICUP. A breakdown of participating institutions by the 2010 Carnegie Classification of Institutions of Higher Education using the Basic Classification Scheme is shown here:

- 6 Associate's Colleges
- 35 Baccalaureate Colleges
- 29 Master's Colleges and Universities
- 7 Research and Doctoral Universities
- 9 Special Focus Institutions

#### Methodology

The designated research liaison at each AICUP member institution was e-mailed a link to an online survey form. A copy of the survey form is included in Appendix B. The respondents were asked to provide "typical" data for academic year 2013-2014 for the following:

- Full-time undergraduate tuition, fees, and room and board charges
- Part-time undergraduate tuition, by day and evening courses
- Full-time and part-time graduate tuition

When the tuition or fees charged by an institution varied by academic program, respondents were asked to list the different tuition or fee charges. These details are included in Appendix A, "Data clarification and notes."

Data collection for the 2013-2014 AICUP Tuition and Fees Survey began in January 2013 and ended in May 2013. Three preliminary reports were produced by AICUP in March 2013, April 2013, and May 2013. The preliminary reports were sent to AICUP member institutions that had submitted 2013-2014 tuition and fees data by that point in time.

Microsoft Excel software was used to create summary information by individual institution, by 2010 Carnegie Classification, and for the entire group of institutions participating in the survey. For individual institutions, this report shows the various educational charges assessed by each institution in the 2012-2013 and the 2013-2014 academic years as well as the percentage change between these two periods. Median statistics were calculated for each type of data (tuition, fees, and room and board) by Carnegie classification and for the entire group of institutions participating in the survey.

The use of medians minimizes but does not eliminate measurement error, in that extreme values in the distribution do not contribute disproportionately to the summary value. However, use caution with median values for an institutional category that are based on a small number of institutions in that category.

Users of this study are strongly encouraged to read the "Data Clarifications and Notes" in Appendix A for additional information on the data submitted by individual institutions and to review institution-specific tuition and fee charges that may vary by program area.
